

10th Judged Las Colcheras Quilt Show 2010 GENERAL RULES



1. Entries will be taken only on Saturday, January 23, 2010 between 9 AM and 3 PM at Peace Lutheran Church, 1701 Missouri Avenue in Las Cruces.
2. Out-of-town entries may be shipped after January 5 by US Mail (USPS) and must be received by Friday, January 22. Ship to: Martha Layman, 1711 Oro Piedras Dr, Las Cruces, NM 88011-4067. Your quilts will be returned to you in the same packaging material in which they were received.
 - By USPS, include a label for return priority shipping and the postage in postal stamps, including insurance.
 - If you are shipping your quilt to the show but intend to pick it up on Sunday, February 7, please indicate this AND enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope. An entry receipt will be mailed to you that must be presented when picking up the quilt.
3. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form. You may enter as many items as you wish, but only one item per category.

4. All entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee. This committee retains the right to change an entry's placement in a category, combine categories with few entries, and/or split categories with many entries.
5. Each quilt must be labeled on the back with the name of the quilt and the quilter's name. Items other than quilts should be labeled in an appropriate location.
6. Each entry must be accompanied by a color photo of the quilt labeled on the back with the entrant's name, name of the quilt, category number, and size of the quilt (height & width). Indicate the top. Snapshots are for layout purposes and will not be returned.
7. Each quilt must have a 4" (2" for small wall hangings) hanging sleeve. If the quilt is longer than 90", the sleeve must be attached 90" from the bottom of the quilt. The sleeve shall be securely stitched top and bottom with no stitches showing on the front. No entries with frames or glass will be accepted. If special hanging devices are required, prior approval from the quilt show committee is required.
8. Indicate on the entry form if the quilt is for sale and the sale price. Las Colcheras will handle the transaction and send a check less 20%.
9. Quilts will have 3 layers with a top, batting, and back held together by hand or machine stitches which must be visible on both sides of the quilt. Theme Quilts and quilts made from kits are not eligible for Best of Show.
10. Judged entries must have been completed after February 10, 2008, be clean, and in good condition. Items may not have been shown in any previous show sponsored by Las Colcheras Quilt Guild.
11. Exhibits will be released for pick up between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM only on Sunday, February 7th at the show. You must have an entry receipt to pick up an item.

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Large Quilts, larger than 60" on any one side, either hand or machine quilted.

- 100 Appliquéd - the work of an individual, predominantly appliquéd.
- 200 Pieced - the work of an individual, predominantly pieced.
- 300 Mixed techniques - the work of an individual, a balanced combination of more than one technique such as pieced and appliquéd, or pieced & embroidery, as an example
- 400 Two person quilts - appliquéd, pieced, or mixed techniques.
- 500 Team quilts (three or more people) - appliquéd, pieced, or mixed techniques (includes Round Robins and Lotto Blocks).

Wall Quilts, larger than 100" perimeter, no side may exceed 60", either hand or machine quilted.

- 600 Appliquéd - the work of an individual, predominantly appliquéd.
- 700 Pieced- the work of an individual, predominantly pieced.
- 800 Mixed techniques - the work of an individual, a balanced combination of more than one technique such as pieced and appliquéd, or pieced and embroidery, as an example
- 900 Two person quilts - appliquéd, pieced, or mixed techniques
- 1000 Team quilts (three or more people). Appliquéd, pieced, or mixed techniques (includes Round Robin and Lotto Blocks).

Other

- 1100 **Small Quilts** (one or more persons). No more than 100 inches perimeter. Any technique may be used. All aspects of the quilt are in reduced scale.
- 1200 **Art Quilts**, any size, the work of an individual. Extends beyond traditional and innovative disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color, or techniques. Quilts must be of fabric, have three layers, and contain quilting with stitches showing on the back.
- 1300 **Pictorial Quilts**, any size and any number of makers, representing a recognizable image. May be any technique including whole cloth, painted, collage, etcetera.
- 1400 **Wearable Art**, must include a recognizable amount of quilting, appliquéd, or piecing. No visible part of the piece may be purchased ready-to-wear.
- 1500 **Miscellaneous Quilts** - Whole cloth, Painted, Cathedral Window, Crazy, Yo-Yo, Kits (*must be identified as such and are not eligible for Best of Show*), etcetera. Any size and the work of any number of people.
- 1600 **Miscellaneous Other** - Pillows, table runners and toppers, ~~baskets~~, purses, bags, and hats. Must include a recognizable amount of quilting, appliquéd, or piecing.
- 1700 **Theme Quilt, Mountain Mysteries**: Anyone may enter this category with a quilt of any size and design depicting the show theme, the work of an individual. *Not eligible for Best of Show.*
- 1800 **Display only**, any size, not judged. Any number of "makers" may be involved. Space permitting, all quilts entered for display will be shown.
- 1900 **Juniors**: Age 17 and under. Any construction and quilting technique. Must be the work of the entrant, but may be made with adult help and supervision. The critique is designed to assist the entrant in improving his/her quilting skills.
